Pentland Brig

General Description:

Pentland Brig is an old fashioned variety that we have rediscovered and are now selling because of its unique sweet taste. It is slightly less curled than most standard kales and has a distinct paler leaf yet is extremely winter hardy. It can be sown from March onwards either as standard kale and the whole leaf used or shredded, or grown on a closer spacing and used at 'teen' leaf size. As young leaves it can be eaten raw, whilst all the leaves taste great lightly stir-fried or steamed to retain their natural goodness.
