British Summertime F1

General Description:

The earliest fruiting courgette in our trials, British Summertime has been bred to yield an abundance of fruit even in cold weather conditions. The plant habit is an exceptionally open spine-free bush which improves air circulation, reducing the incidence of disease and fruit rot, allowing for the rapid picking of top quality dark green fruit.

Fruit Shape:	Cylindrical
Flower Scar:	5
Feature:	Very vigorous, open, early plant giving good yield

Spines: 1 = Many, 5 = Very few
Fruit Colour: 1 = Pale, 5 = Dark

Fruit Uniformity: 1 = Poor, 5 = Uniform
Flower Scar: 1 = Large, 5 = Small
