General Description:

A hybrid dwarf type with typical short, sturdy white leaf stalks and dark green slightly savoyed leaves with a mild and crunchy flavour. Plant height 12 to 14cm. Slower bolting than other white varieties. Can be picked as 'baby choi' or left to mature, versatile vegetable for salads or stir-fries
