

## **Sweet Pepper**

Capsicum annuum

## **Padron**

## **General Description:**

Spanish `Tapas' pepper. Fruits are conical, slightly wrinkled with a long curved stalk. Fruits should be picked at green immature stage when only a small percentage will be hot.

## **Profile:**

<b>Plant Habit</b>	Large plant, short internodes and small leaves
Fruit Habit	Pendant
<b>Fruit Colour</b>	Green (Red if left to mature)
Fruit Shape	Conical or truncated-conical
Fruit Size	3-5 cm (length) x 2-2.5 cm (diameter)
Scoville rating	5,000 ( if left to over mature)
Taste	Spicy and sweet, but not too hot
Remarks	From the municipality of Padrón in the province of A Coruña, Galicia, northwestern Spain.  Requires picking at an immature stage, and frequent harvesting is essential. If fruits are left to get bigger than 5cm they will become guite pungent.
