Chillies are ready in as quickly as 50 days from sowing and plants continue to crop for at least 3 months, if picked regularly. Quickfire chilli gives the unique flexibility of being suitable for sowing at any time of the year, so you can have a succession of plants producing fresh chillies on your windowsill all year round!
