### General Description:

A premium hybrid butternut squash, Inca Gold is a South American 'Coquina' type bred especially to be easier to cultivate, even in cooler climates. Producing reliable earlier yields of extra sweet uniform fruits, Inca Gold has an exceptional deep orange flesh with a small seed cavity and a unique mottled green and tan skin finish when ripe. Fruits continue to ripen and increase in sweetness post-harvest with careful storage.
