Gold Speck F1

A prolific cropper with uniform fruits, Gold Speck is a firm favourite. Orange, scalloped fruit approx. 110g. Most fruit set close to the crown early and escape virus flecking.



Jill Be Little

A prolific yielding, mini ornamental pumpkin. Perfect for autumnal decoration due to its size and scalloped shape. Fruits 200-250 grams.



Baby Bear

This mini pumpkin is the perfect size for young children with a weight of around 1kg and a slender handle. Great for decorative use and their semi-hulless seeds can be roasted for snacks.



Fright Night F1

We are excited to introduce this small dark orange pumpkin to the UK market. It has performed consistently well in our trials in both Surrey and further north.



Rocket F1

Established variety. oval fruited, large vine type with orange colouring and strong handles, mid-season maturity and good vields. dependable.



Racer F1

Our best selling Hallowe'en variety, 5 to 7 kg round fruits with strong handles. Semibush variety which matures early, it is consistent and high yielding.



Cauldron F1 PMR

A hybrid pumpkin with uniform oval fruits, dark orange colouring and strong handles. It is a large vine type with mid-season maturity and good yields. PMR (Powdery mildew resistance).



Cargo F1 PMR

Medium to large-size Jack-o'-Lantern hybrid pumpkin with strong green handles. It's a bright orange globe shape with fruits about 6-10kg PMR (powdery mildew resistance).



Wicked F1

A Tozer bred variety, which produces a high-quality, large, 'monster' pumpkin, ideal for Halloween. It is well-suited to cultivation in cooler climates such as the UK and can thrive even in poor summers as it is early to mature.

Butternut



Hunter F1

Bred by Tozer for the Northern European climate, Hunter is up to four weeks earlier to harvest than US hybrids. Fruits average 1– 1.5kg with a high level of marketable yield.



Autumn Crown F1

Autumn Crown produces an abundance of attractive early maturing butternut coloured scalloped fruits each weighing around 2 kg from reduced vines.

The long-storing fruits have a unique 'sweet melon' aroma when cut.



Sweetmax F1

This processing type has large 3.5 kg fruits with great internal colour and flavour. This traditional shaped butternut grows on a full vine plant and has the potential to produce a large amount of uniform fruits.



Inca Gold

American 'Coquina' type
bred to be easier to
cultivate, in cooler
climates. Producing
reliable earlier yields of
sweet, uniform fruits, it
has an exceptional deep
orange flesh, small seed
cavity and a unique
mottled green and tan
skin finish. Fruits continue
to ripen and increase in
sweetness post-harvest.
